New Judge's Qualifications

Chris Utterback, Committee Chair presented the following new qualifications.

Upon receipt of the application and fee, Judge's applicants will receive the Judge's Manual and ideal fleece samples. They will receive a form outlining requirements for practical experience to be completed within 6 months of receipt of the manual and fleece samples.

Requirements:

- 1) Participate as an exhibitor in at least two goat (any breed not just pygora) shows or 4 any other species of animal. They can be 4-H or open shows.
- 2) Volunteer as Show Steward, Ring Steward or Local Show Secretary.
- 3) Volunteer to be the Judge's assistant for at least one goat show. (Any breed not just pygora).

All the requirements listed above may be waved if the person is a licensed judge for any recognized goat breed.

Once the requirements are met and documented on the form they will return the

form to the Judge's Training Committee Chairperson. The JTC chair will then send them the Judge's Test and Fleece Test Samples. From that date they have 6 months to complete and submit the test for review by the JTC.

The Judge's Applicant must be a member in good standing with Pygora Breeders Association.

Free two year membership is no longer offered to applicants passing the test.
