

Pygora® Goat Show Information: Morning & Afternoon Shows!

!! Morning Show: Sat. Aug. 17th 2019 at **9 a.m.** **Afternoon Show:** Sat. Aug. 17th 2019 at **2 p.m.!!**

Place: Allegan County Fairground, 150 Douglas St, Allegan, MI 49010; Sheep Barn

Times: Unless arrangements are made in advance with the show chairperson, check-in must be at the fairgrounds between 12 Noon and 7 PM on Friday August 16th. Release time is Sunday at 4 PM. Early releases for out of state exhibitors will be at the discretion of the Pygora Goat Committee.

Entry Fees: \$8.00 per entry per class. When you sign up for a class, please list the class number and ALSO check the box(es) for AM/PM. Separate entry fees are charged for both AM and PM shows; group classes will be charged as one entry fee per group entered.

Pen Fees: Pen fees are \$15.00 per pen used, either for tack or goats. Pen sizes are 6'x 6' and will accommodate 4 medium sized Pygora goats or approximately 6 kids comfortably. Unless specified, pens will be reserved in the doe area. Tack pens available as space permits. One pen reservation will cover either all housing, regardless of sign-up for a single show or two shows. Hay and straw may be purchased on site separately.

Rules

1. All rules and regulations of the Pygora Breeder's Association will be enforced. PBA Show Rules will be available at the show.
2. All goats must have an original PBA certificate of registration to enter, and certificates need to reflect correct gender. Pre-registration forms are allowed for goats up to 1 year of age. Certificates must be available during check in and during the show.
3. All Pygora goats 1 year and older must be shown in fleece or with fleece in a box to be presented to judge. The fleece must be the current year's latest clip.
4. All goats will be shown under the owner's name as listed on the registration certificate; the exception is for a new owner with the original registration certificate and a signed transfer form, IF the transfer date is ≤ 60 days of the show date.
5. All group classes must be registered on the entry form. Group classes will not be accepted on the day of show.
6. **All goats from out-of-state need a health certificate completed within 30 days of entry, by a veterinarian licensed in the animal's state of origin; health form must include individual PBA animal registration numbers (can be a single document).**
